

FAMILY VACATION IN VIETNAM & THAILAND

14 DAYS/13 NIGHTS

Day 01: Bangkok Arrival

Arrive at Bangkok Airport, our guide will welcome and transfer to hotel for check-in. Overnight in Bangkok.

Day 02: Bangkok – Half day city tour (B, D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning is free at your leisure. In the afternoon, you will visit Royal Grand Palace. This is the perfecting introduction to Thailand, the Buddhist faith, regal splendor and traditional, though no longer the royal residence. It remains the symbol of the kingdom. You'll visit the key attractions around The Grand Palace including Wat Phra Kaew Temple of the Emerald Buddha, Coronation Throne Hall, Royal Reception Hall, Royal Funeral Hall, the Golden Chedi and the Royal Pantheon. In the evening, enjoy dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight in Bangkok.

Day 03: Half Day Tour Damnoensaduak Floating Market (B, D)

Breakfast at hotel, in the early morning, our guide will pick you up at the hotel and then transfer to one of the most attracting floating market of Thailand namely Damnoensaduak Floating Market. There you have a chance to take a boat observing the lifestyle of local people along the small canals. Not only do you visit the coconut farm and taste some coconut juice but also you will find the variety of seasonal fruits such as durian, mangoes, papaya and etc. Then, we back to the hotel and free at leisure or shopping in the afternoon. Evening, our guide will take you to Indian restaurant for dinner. Overnight in Bangkok.

Day 04: Bangkok – Chiang Mai – Elephant Farm – Khantoke Dinner (B, L, D) (By flight)

Breakfast at hotel then transfer to airport for take flight to The North of Thailand that is Chiang Mai. Arrival in Chiang Mai, we start tour to Patara Elephant farm trip "Elephant Owner For A Day" is a specialized and meaningful day trip with happy elephants and their babies. It's a great day out for visitors who want to be with, learn, take care for elephants and riding elephant bare back as what's an elephant care taker would do daily to keep an elephants healthy.

Trip is suitable for all especially lovers, friends, and family with children (not for those who expect to see elephant dancing and perform tricks or walk on their two legs)

Trip base on 1 on 1 with your own elephant.

Including: specialized training trip with elephant, transportation, traditional Thai picnic lunch, drinking water and complementary DVD photos & videos of your activity.meet the tour guide and then transfer to the hotel and relax on own.

In the evening enjoy the famous dinner "Khantoke Dinner" (Indian meal) or known as the Northern welcome dinner including hill tribe dancing. Overnight in Chiang Mai.

Day 05: Chiang Mai – Phuket (B)

Free until transfer you to airport for flight to Phuket. On arrival, check in hotel. Rest of the day is free at beach. Overnight in Phuket

Day 06: Free Time on Beach (B)

Free leisure at beach. Overnight in Phuket

Day 08: Phuket – Hanoi

Boarding flight to Hanoi. On arrival, transfer you to hotel for check-in. Overnight in Hanoi

Day 09: Hanoi City Tour

Today is an unforgettable day for Hanoi. You will start with a nice buffet breakfast at your hotel, where you can enjoy some Vietnamese coffee, if you are a coffee lover. The first stop is Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, where Uncle Ho-Father of the Vietnamese, is laid out in state. Here we also visit the Presidential Palace where Ho refused to live, choosing instead a small stilt house beside a lake. Close by is the One Pillar Pagoda. A tour around the beautiful West Lake then takes us to the venerable

Temple of Literature.

In the afternoon, you will visit the Vietnam Museum of Ethnology, with its art and artifacts from the 54 different ethnic groups that inhabit the country, is a must for all visitors. See examples of the traditional clothing and way of life, as well as reconstructions of traditional longhouses, cemeteries and other distinctive ethnic buildings.

The sightseeing today ends with an interesting discovery of Hanoi's Old Quarter (also called "36 streets") by Xich Lo, a local transport similar to the Tuk Tuk in Thailand. Be fascinated by the narrow alleys and shop houses. Finally, in the evening you can enjoy a traditional water puppet show, before dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight in Hanoi.

Day 10: Hanoi – Halong Bay

After breakfast, Around 8:30 am start a trip to Halong Bay. On the way, enjoy the landscape of Vietnam from rural villages to industries. Upon arrival in Halong Bay, complimentary tea before boarding for the overnight cruise. And then enjoy your seafood lunch. The scenery is truly stunning with some visits such as Sung Sot Cave, Tuan Chau Island, and Dinh Huong Island, Ga Choi Island, Dog Island, Sail Island and a swim at Titop beach. Kayaking or swimming from the vessel's stern deck at the Hang Trong anchorage. Enjoy a wonderful night on boat in your luxury private cabin. Sleeping in the tender sound of waves and hearing the soft voice of your beloved one whispering to you: "Every moment I spent with you...is like a beautiful dream come true." . Overnight on the boat
Meal; Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 11: Halong Bay – Hanoi – Ho Chi Minh

Learn ancient art of Tai Chi on Sundeck under early morning blaze of arrange saffron when the Sun rise out behind thousand of precipitous limestone islands on the bay with lovely chirping sound of morning birds. For the early riser, complimentary tea, coffee and breakfast will be served. You will visit the impressive Cave of Halong Bay – Surprising Cave (Sừng Sốt) with your tour guide, a truly Awesome and amazing cave to experience. After then, check out of your cabin and settle your bill as our boat begins cruising back to the harbor. Experience more views of Halong Bay such as Fighting Cocks Island (Symbol of Halong Bay), Incense Burner and Stone Dogs Islands. Lunch is served on board during cruising towards the harbor. Around noon, depart the Cruiser and travel by tender boat back to Tuan Chau International Marina where you meet our guide again then transfer you to airport for flight to Ho Chi Minh. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh. Meal; Breakfast, Lunch

Day 12: Ho Chi Minh – Cuchi Tunnels

After breakfast, you will proceed to Cu Chi to explore the amazing site where the Viet Cong hid during the Vietnam War. It is now a popular spot for both Vietnamese and foreign tourists and includes a network of over 120 miles (200 kilometers) of tunnels that became legendary for their vital role in the Vietnam War. In their heyday, the tunnels were functioning underground cities, including numerous trap doors, specially constructed living areas, storage facilities, weapons factories, field hospitals, command centers and kitchens. There is plenty of evidence of the fierce battle that took place during the 1960s when Cu Chi was a "Free Target Zone". You can watch a short introductory video that shows how the tunnels were constructed, before entering the tunnels themselves. Spend an hour exploring the tunnels. Afterwards you will pause for tea and cassava, typical guerrilla food during wartime. Afternoon, we do the city tour with visiting the former Presidential Palace, the imposing Notre Dame Cathedral and the French style central Post Office and Ben Thanh Market. Overnight in Saigon

Day 13: Ho Chi Minh – Mekong Delta

Just two hours by road from Ho Chi Minh's bustling streets, you'll start venturing into the watery world of the Mekong Delta. As a highlight of the trip, we take a cruise along the narrow waterways through the lush vegetation to an orchard garden where we have the opportunity to visit local homes as well as enjoy a lunch followed with seasonal fruits and a local folk song performance. Stop at a coconut mill and the Vinh Trang Pagoda on the way back to Saigon. Optional fun for the evening is a Vespa Tour through the city where you can enjoy the street food spots and some great live music at a local bar or cafe (not included in the package price). Meal: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 14: Depart Hanoi

Free until transfer you to airport for flight to home. Meal: Breakfast
