Day 01: Bangkok Arrival

Welcome you to Bangkok city tour, our guide will pick up and transfer you to hotel. Bangkok, also known as the City of Angels and Venice of the East, will hit you like a ton of bricks. Hot, polluted, and chaotic, it thrills with energy, and the sightseeing, shopping, and eating possibilities are so vast that you'll have little time to rest. If you find a free moment today, you can pamper yourself at spas, skyline-view bars or excellent restaurants. Overnight in Bangkok

Day 02: Royal Grand Palace (Half Day) & Dinner Cruise

After your breakfast at your hotel, you will be collected for your tour of The Royal Grand Palace. The palace has a common compound which it shares with [Wat PhraKaew](#), home of the Emerald Buddha. Both places have their own unique architecture with the Temple with its authentic Thai style and the Palace with its Western components. Wander around the beautiful grounds of both and visit the massive coronation hall of the palace. When you are finished you will be taken back to your hotel for free time until you are collected for tonight's Dinner Cruise at around 7.30pm. This Chao Phraya River Dinner Cruise has some great photo opportunities including the Temple of Dawn and the Royal Grand Palace. Around 8pm enjoy a wonderful romantic candle lit dinner featuring live music. The scrumptious International buffet has varied dishes ranging from entrees, mains and deserts and is sure to be a hit. Arrive back at River City around 9.45pm for your transfer back to the hotel. Meal: Breakfast, Dinner

Day 03: Bangkok – Chiang Mai

When you arrive you will be met by your guide who will take you to your nominated hotel for check in. After freshening up and settling in, you will be taken to a beautiful hill top location to a Meo Hill Tribe Village where you will meet Meo Tribesmen dressed in their traditional and colorful clothing. From here you will be taken to Doi Suthep Temple and Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep which is located on a hilltop and contains the holy relic of Lord Buddha. The panoramic views from here are breathtaking. Return back to your hotel and relax until dinner time when you will have the opportunity to partake in a 'Khantoke Dinner'. Dinners sit on the floors to eat whilst being entertained by traditional dances and music including Candle dancing, finger dancing, Sword dancing and much more. Return back to your hotel and have the rest of the evening to yourself. Stay at your hotel tonight in Chiang Mai. Meal: Breakfast, Dinner

Day 04: Elephant Conservation Centre (Half Day)

Fill up on your breakfast at your hotel this morning before departing for the 26 km journey to see elephants at work. You will see a performance by elephants and their trainers demonstrating their daily chores. Next move onto a magnificent Orchid and Butterfly farm.. Overnight Chiang Mai. Meal: Breakfast

Day 09: Hanoi City Tour

Today is an unforgettable day for Hanoi. Morning, you will start with a nice buffet breakfast at your hotel, where you can enjoy some Vietnamese coffee, if you are a coffee lover. The first stop is Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, where Uncle Ho is laid out in state, surrounded by immaculately dressed soldiers. Next we will visit the Presidential Palace where Ho refused to live, choosing instead a small stilt house beside a lake. Close by, the next stop is the One Pillar Pagoda the venerable Temple of Literature. In the afternoon, you will visit the Vietnam Museum of Ethnology is a must for all visitors; it's one of the most interesting museums in Hanoi with many different things relating the 54 Vietnamese ethnic groups. Discover the Old Quarter of Hanoi by cyclo. This fascinating area of narrow alleys and shop houses is also called "36 streets". Then, enjoy Water puppet show – the unique Traditional Art in the North of Vietnam before tucking into the hotel. Meal: Breakfast

Day 10: Hanoi – Halong Bay

After breakfast, at around 8 am start your journey to Halong Bay and arrive at around midday to board a traditional junk for an overnight cruise. On the way, enjoy the landscape of the Red River Delta countryside including rice fields, water buffalo and everyday Vietnamese village life. Halong Bay, in the Gulf of Tonkin, includes some 1,600 islands and islets, forming a spectacular seascape of limestone pillars. Upon arrival, you will enjoy a welcome coffee upon arrival in Halong bay before boarding for the overnight boat trip. Enjoy your great seafood lunch on board then we begin our fantastic cruise on Halong Bay. The scenery is truly breathtaking and is continuously changing. This includes a visit to Sung Sot Cave, Tuan Chau Island, and Dinh Huong Island, Ga Choi Island, Dog Island, Sail Island and a swim at Titop beach. Kayak or swim from the vessel's stern deck at the Hang Trong anchorage, whet your appetite with an onboard cooking demonstration. After sunset, enjoy a lovely dinner on the boat. Sleeping in the tender sound of waves. Overnight on the boat on the beautiful quiet bay. Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 11: Halong Bay – Hanoi

Wake up the next morning at sunrise, feel the early morning salt water scent; bask in the early sun rising from behind the mountains while complimentary tea & coffee are served. This morning, you will then visit Vung Vieng Fishing Village on small bamboo paddle boat manned by our staff and enjoy the quiet atmosphere enclosed by high islets and mountains before being returned to our junk.
